Welcome Willis Moore

Our substitute organist this month is Willis H A Moore. He is the spouse of Rev. Alison M Dingley, who was our supply priest last year. Willis has been an adjunct Professor of History and Political Science at Chaminade University since 1986, where he teaches US History and World Civilization. He also works for the College Board grading advanced placement exams. He is House Manager for TAG The Actors' Group, an elected member of the Downtown/Chinatown Neighborhood Board, a writer and musician. Since moving to Hawai'i in 1962, Moore served as organist for the University Avenue Baptist Church, for the Command Chapel at Fort Shafter, and for St Christopher's and St Luke's Episcopal Churches on O'ahu. He was organist/choir master for Temple Emanu-El from 1968-1990; and he served at St Paul's Episcopal/I.F.I. which meets on the Cathedral close. From 2006-2015, while Pastor Alison was serving three congregations in Eastern Oregon as Interim Priest, Moore played organ for St Paul's in The Dalles, for St Paul's in Klamath Falls, and for Church of the Redeemer in Pendleton, Oregon, during his visits with her.
